

CLEANING PROCEDURE FOR STAINS ON YES ESSENTIALS® UPHOLSTERY FABRIC

If a stain has occurred on YES Essentials fabric:

1. Using a towel (paper or cloth), gently blot or wipe the stain to remove excess stain. Avoid pressing the stain into the fabric or spreading the stain to the surrounding fabric. With each blot, use a clean area of the towel. Continue blotting with a clean section of towel until all excess stain has been removed from the surface of the fabric.
2. Dampen the towel with water and gently wipe the stained area with an upward motion. Wipe from the outside of the stain towards the center of the stain so as not to spread the stain. With each wipe, use a clean section of towel. As stain gradually disappears, gradually apply more pressure during wipe motion. Wipe until stain is no longer visible.
3. Blot cleaned area with a dry cloth.

If stains persist:

1. Use a cleaning wipe that contains soap (such as Armor All Cleaning Wipes) to gently wipe the stained area with an upward motion. **Only a minimum amount of soap should be used.** Wipe from the outside of the stain towards the center of the stain so as not to spread the stain. With each wipe, use a clean section of towel. As stain gradually disappears, gradually apply more pressure during wipe motion. Wipe until stain is no longer visible.
2. After removing stain, use a fresh, damp (water only) towel to blot out all soap remaining in the cleaned area of fabric.

If stains persist:

1. Sparingly spray a cleaning solution (such as a laundry stain remover) onto the stained area. **Only a minimum amount of soap should be used.** Using a towel (paper or cloth) gently wipe the stained area with an upward motion. Wipe from the outside of the stain towards the center of the stain so as not to spread the stain. With each wipe, use a clean section of towel. As stain gradually disappears, gradually apply more pressure during wipe motion. Wipe until stain is no longer visible.
2. After removing stain, use a fresh damp (water only) towel to blot out all soap remaining in the cleaned area of the fabric.
